In 1999 he was appointed to the President's Export Council (PEC), which advised the administration on trade and export policy, and served as chairman of the PEC Subcommittee on Encryption. He has served the Department of Defense and other government agencies on multiple advisory committees.

A widely recognized expert on network and information security issues, Crowell has appeared on and consults with national and local television programs, and has been quoted in many trade and business publications including the Wall Street Journal, BusinessWeek, Information Week, Network World, Computer World, Federal Computer Week.
