



General Dennis J. Reimer, Former Army Chief of Staff, Joins VirtualAgility as Advisor

In 2006 Reimer became president of DFI Government Services, a knowledge management company dealing with national security issues. In 2007 Detica, a British firm specializing in information intelligence, purchased DFI-Government Services and he currently serves as Chief Strategy Officer and Member of the Board for DeticaDFI. As to why he is working with VirtualAgility, General Reimer said: "I am impressed with the dedication and innovation of the VirtualAgility people and look forward to trying to help them solve some of the most pressing problems facing us in preserving our national security."
