Piernick was responsible for briefing senior members of the U.S. intelligence community on national security matters, such as homeland security, terrorism, weapons of mass destruction, narcotics trafficking and violent street gangs.

Piernick received his Juris Doctor degree from Wake Forest University, an M.A. in Management & Public Administration from Webster University and a B.A. in History from the Virginia Military Institute. He is currently a member of North Carolina and Florida State Bar Associations.
